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1 SINGAPORE → NAGOYA

2 NAGOYA ~ SAKE BREWERY ~ HIDA TAKAYAMA (MOB/LD)

- **Hida Takayama** is a city in the mountainous Hida region of Gifu Prefecture. Takayama retains a traditional touch like few other Japanese cities, especially in its beautifully preserved old town.
- **Hida Takayama Funasaka Sake Brewery** ~ Sake is brewed with fine spring and good quality rice special for sake brewing in a cold climate. Please enjoy the real taste of sake here.
- **Takayama Jinya** ~ A beautiful traditional Japanese style building, used to serve as Takayama's government office during Edo period.
- **Takayama Festival Float Exhibition Hall** ~ The Takayama Festival, held in spring (April 14 and 15) and autumn (October 9 and 10), is ranked as one of Japan's three most beautiful festivals.

3 HIDA TAKAYAMA ~ GASSHO VILLAGE ~ KANAZAWA (BLD)

- **Miyagawa Morning Market** is one of the biggest morning markets in Japan. Most stands sell local crafts, snacks and farm products such as vegetables, pickles and flowers.

Village of Shirakawa-go

It is one of Japan's UNESCO World Heritage Sites. This village is well known for their houses constructed in the architectural style known as gassho-zukuri. The Gassho-zukuri, "prayer-hands construction" style is characterized by a thatched and steeply slanting roof resembling two hands joined in prayer.

- **Tenshukaku Observation Point** ~ A picturesque view of the gassho village can be seen from this point.
- **Wada Family Residence** ~ this well-preserved house is the largest remaining Gassho style house in Shirakawa-go and is now open to the public as a museum.
- **Myozen-ji** ~ Impressive transom carvings are located inside the building is a beautiful yew tree that is designated as a one of Gifu Prefecture's natural monuments.
- **Deai Bridge** ~ A special design bridge which connects between Shirakawago gassho villages.
- **Omicho Market** ~ Kanazawa's largest fresh food market since the Edo Period.
- **Kenrokuen** ~ is justifiably classified as one of Japan's "three most beautiful landscape gardens".
- **Kanazawa Castle** ~ is a large, well-restored castle in Kanazawa.

4 KANAZAWA ~ KUROBE ALPINE ROUTE ~ MATSUMOTO (BLD)

Today's Highlights: ~

The 90km adventure of Tateyama ~ Kurobe Alpine route.

Begin the Alpine route tour by buses and cable car as assigned by the authorities:

- Tateyama → Bijyo-Daira by Cable Railway (7 min for 1.7 km) Sea level 977M.
- Bijyodaira → Midagahara → Tengudaira → Murodo by Highland Bus (50 min for 23 km) Sea level 2450M.
- Lunch will be serve by Japanese Local lunch box called "Obento" Sea level 2450M.
- Murodo → Daikanbo by Tunnel Trolley Bus (10 min for 3.7 km) Sea level 2316M.
- Daikanbo → Kurobedaira by Ropeway (7 minutes for 1.7 km) Sea level 1828M.
- Kurobedaira → Lake Kurobe By Subway (5 min for 0.8 km) Sea level 1455M.
- Lake Kurobe → Kurobe Dam (15 min walk for 0.8 km) Sea level 1470M.
- Kurobe Dam → Ogisawa by Train (16 Min for 6.1KM) Sea level 1433M.

5 MATSUMOTO ~ HOTAKASO ROPEWAY ~ OKUHIDA (BLD)

- **Yubatake** - Literally "hot water field", has come to symbolize Kusatsu Hot Spring.
- **Yukemuri-tei** - Situated next to Yubatake, this is a free of charge footbath.
- **Shin-Hotaka Ropeway** ~ The first double decker ropeway in Japan. It also offers excellent view of Northern Japanese Alps. (Subject to Weather Condition)
- **Okuhida Bear Park** featuring Asian black bears. You can also feed the bears, and watch their amusing gestures as they ask for food.

6 TAGATA SHRINE ~ FACTORY OUTLET ~ NAGOYA (BLD)

- **Tagata Shrine** ~ the "secret shrine of Japan" symbolizing manhood.
- **Branded Factory Outlet** ~ one of the famous factory outlet shopping where lots of International & Japanese branded items are on sale at discounted price ~ must grab!
- **JR Central Towers** While the building's lower floors are shared between the two towers and house a Takashimaya department store, the Tower Plaza shopping mall and JR Nagoya Station.
