

DAY 01 SINGAPORE / DELH

(Lunch/Dinner)

Assemble at Singapore Changi International Airport for your flight to **Delhi**.

Your tour in Delhi includes visits to **Qutab Minar**. One of the tallest tower of it's time, this imposing five storey tower was built in 1193AD by Qutubuddin Aibak, a slave of the Muslim raider Mohammad Ghauri, to mark the first Muslim dynasty in India. Housed next to it is the Quwwat-ul-Islam Mosque, a novel construction of Islamic domes and architects and carved decorative panels from the Jain and Hindu Temples. It is a World Heritage Monument today. Next, drive past the **India Gate**, a war memorial dedicated to the unknown soldiers; **Embassy Area**, a diplomatic enclave and historic government buildings like the President's House and Parliament House..

DAY 02 DELHI / JODHPUR

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Board your **domestic flight** for **Jodhpur** in the morning.

Welcome to Rajasthan, the land of kings, endowed with magnificent havelis, beautiful palaces, forts and rich cultural heritage.

First stop is Jodhpur - the largest city in Rajasthan after Jaipur. It is affectionately referred to as the 'Blue City' because of the indigo-colored houses in the old town.

Have your lunch in Jodhpur upon arrival. Spend some time at the **local market**.

DAY 03 JODHPUR / JAISALMER

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

An urban sea of indigo washed buildings, Jodhpur in the Indian state of Rajasthan certainly earns its name as 'The Blue City.' Sitting on an arid swath of land near the Thar Desert bordering Pakistan, the blue cubist outpost makes for an interesting contrast between man, beauty, squalor and the natural setting. The city can best be seen from the ramparts of the mighty **Meherangarh Fort**, which looms high above the buzzing city. Sprawled across a 125m high hill, this is the most formidable fort in fort-studded Rajasthan. It is a must visit place while on Jodhpur travel. The fort has a unique architecture with exquisitely carved panels, lattice windows and evocative names.



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You will catch a view of the Jaswant Thada, a 19th century royal cenotaph built in commemoration of Maharaja Jaswant Singh II, the 33rd Rathore ruler of Jodhpur. It is located to the left of the Mehrangarh Fort. After lunch, continue the drive to Jaisalmer.

DAY 04 JAISALMER

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Unlike any other city, this desert fortress is one of Rajasthan's most exotic and unusual towns. Jaisalmer, an important ancient trading centre because of its strategic location on the camel trade routes, is often described as the 'Yellow City'.

First stop of the day is the **Gadisar Tank**. Located south of the city walls, Gadisar Tank was once the water supply of the city and there are many small temples and shrines around it. The attractive gateway which arches across the road down to the tank is said to have been built by a famous prostitute. Next stop is the **Jaisalmer Fort**, the only living fort in India today, built by Rawal Jaisal in the 12th century with a population of 5,000. Within the fort lies the **Jain Temples** built between 12th and 15th centuries.

Move on across the **Market Place** to **Patwa Haveli**. This magnificent of all the Jaisalmer havelis stands in a narrow lane exquisitely carved from golden-yellow sandstone and are still in a beautiful condition. Round off your tour with a **camel safari** at the Sam Sand Dunes.

DAY 05 JAISALMER / JODHPUR / DELHI / AGRA

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

Rise early as you travel back to Jodhpur this morning to catch your domestic flight back to Delhi.

Upon arrival in Delhi have your dinner and transfer to your hotel in Agra for a good night's rest.

Overnight : Agra

DAY 06 AGRA / DELHI

(Breakfast / Lunch / Dinner)

See one of the Seven Wonders of the World, Taj Mahal, built by Shah Jahan to immortalize his love for his wife, Mumtaz Mahal. Later, visit a cottage industry to witness skilled craftsmen doing fine marble inlay and the Agra Fort. Built in 1569 on the banks of the Yamuna River, it is here that the Emperor Shah Jahan spent the rest of his life imprisoned, looking out along the river of the final resting place of his wife before returning to Delhi for night's rest.

DAY 07 DELHI / SINGAPORE

(Breakfast / Dinner)

Spend some time hunting for bargains at the famous **Connaught Place** (on your own), the trademark shopping area in Delhi before being transferred to the airport for your returning flight.

DAY 08 ARRIVED IN SINGAPORE

Remarks :
