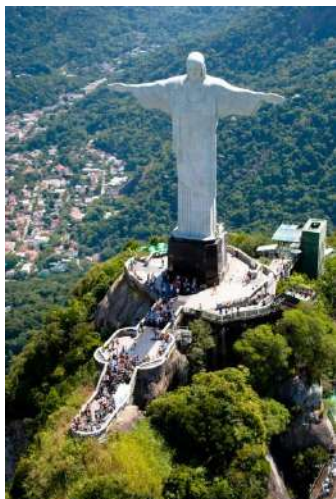

Day 01 SINGAPORE – DUBAI – RIO DE JANEIRO MOB/-/D

Full day Corcovado and Sugar with lunch at Galetto Sats

After breakfast, proceed to visit the most famous landmarks sites of the city and see the natural beauty of Rio from above. After a scenic drive along Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon, arrive at the bottom of the Corcovado Hill. The Corcovado Hill is part of the Tijuca Forest which is the largest urban forest in the World. On the way to its top is the Dona Marta belvedere, from where is possible to see the Maracanã Stadium, the famous Guanabara Bay and the beautiful Sugar Loaf. Once at the top of Corcovado Hill, it is possible to admire breathtaking views of Copacabana, Ipanema, Leblon, Rodrigo de Freitas Lagoon and the Botanical Garden.

Embark on a comfortable train that ascends the mountain and get to the statue of Christ the Redeemer, located 2,300 ft above sea level. Once at the top, use the panoramic elevators or escalators to get to the foot of the statue, as well as enjoy a panoramic view of Rio de Janeiro. After that proceed to Sugar Loaf Mountain.

Every year, over a million tourists visit the internationally famous Pão de Açúcar (Sugar Loaf Mountain), an iconic symbol of the city of Rio de Janeiro. Its name was given due to the

Today we will do a **HD Brazilian Falls** with lunch at Porto Canoas restaurant (drinks not included). The Brazilian Falls are located on the western side of the Paraná State in Brazil. They were declared Natural World Heritage in the year 1986 by UNESCO. This Brazilian park with 185,000 hectares (458,000 acres) borders the Argentinean National Park and they are divided by the Iguazu River. Both parks make this region one of the largest natural protected areas in South America. The tour starts at the Visitor Center designed to be the gateway to the Park, operates as a visitor boarding and landing center since to access the route of the footbridges it is necessary to go with modern panoramic buses that make the transfer inside from the park. The extension of the footbridges is 1,200 meters from

where you get a spectacular panoramic view of the 275 falls that make up the Iguazu Falls, of which the most important on the Brazilian side are four: Florian, Deodoro, Benjamín Constant and Salto Unión or Devil's Throat. Once the walk is over we will reached the panoramic elevator that allows us to get to the bus that will take us again to the access gate. Dinner at hotel's restaurant. Hotel : TBA/ Iguassu

Day 05**FOZ DO IGUASSU**

FD Argentina Falls included in the New Seven Wonders of Nature list, the wonderful Iguazu Falls are located in the border that divides Brazil, Argentine and Paraguay, what gives one the opportunity to admire the natural show from different angles. Many observation decks, suspended walkways and transportation modes are disposed to provide the best experiences. It is incredible to appreciate the immensity and strength of the water that falls uninterruptedly. The Argentinean side has two thirds of the falls of Iguazu Falls, what makes the visit exciting, as one could feel the strength of the waterfalls very closely. There are trails and two circuits around the park, so one can admire the natural phenomenon from different angles. One of the most incredible experiences is to go to Devil's Throat, where is possible

to see the strong waterfall from the top. On the transfer to the Argentine side of Iguazu Falls, you will cross a bridge with 480 meters in length that was built in 1985, known popularly as the "International Fraternity Bridge" although its official name is International Tancredo Neves Bridge, connecting Brazil (Foz do Iguazu) and Argentina (Puerto Iguazu) which leads to the Guests Center and the Iguazu National Park Entrance, which has snack bars, a restaurant, souvenir shops, toilets, medical attention and an interpretive building with giant panels showing the biodiversity of the subtropical humid forest. To get to the catwalks and see the Falls, you need to take the gas-propelled train that will lead to the Upper Falls Circuits, for walks around forests and beautiful landscapes, and especially the Devil's Throat, which provides one of the best views of the Falls, due to the impact of the water that makes big clouds of steam and form an incredible rainbow. **GREAT ADVENTURE BOAT TOUR INCLUDED.** Dinner at barbecue restaurant.

Make sure to sample some 'empanadas' baked in traditional clay ovens.

Afternoon visit to the **fortress of Ollantaytambo** where the Temple of the sun (formed of six gigantic monoliths, whose total weight exceeds 50 tons) and the Terrace of the Ten Niches stand out. Dinner at sonesta Posadas del Inca Yucay.

Day 08**SACRED VALLEY – MACHU PICCHU – CUSCO**

Today transfer to the train station for your journey through the **Sacred Valley of the Incas up to Manchu Picchu**. Upon arrival in Aguas Calientes you will be greeted by guided who will assist you onto the shuttle bus to the entrance of the citadel. During your guided tour you will experience the uniqueness of the location and the genius that went into its construction. The duration of your magical trip to one of the seven new wonders of the world will be 2.5 hours, after which you will make your way back out of the citadel with your guide. Head back down to Aguas Calientes to enjoy some lunch at El Mapi by Inkaterra. Later in the afternoon, return by train from Aguas Calientes to Ollanta Station. Upon arrival transfer to hotel for check in. Dinner at Xima Cusco.

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Enjoy spectacular panoramic views of three Palcoyo **Rainbow Mountain** peaks in this full-day trip to Palcoyo, also known as the “Alternative Rainbow Mountain”. You will be picked up from hotel early in the morning at 0500hr and set out on a drive through the South Valley and towards the trailhead at Palcoyo (approx. 3.5hrs). On the way, pass the rio Rojo, a river in which reddish water flows depending on the weather. From the trailhead you will begin your short uphill walk for 45 minutes to Palcoyo Pass (5000m/16400ft) where you will have a spectacular view of the multi-coloured vistas across the Palcoyo Rainbow Mountain peaks as well as the highest mountain in the Cusco region, Ausangate. You will spend approx. 1 hour at the pass, taking pictures of the vibrantly colored landscape and enjoying the awe-inspiring view. Once

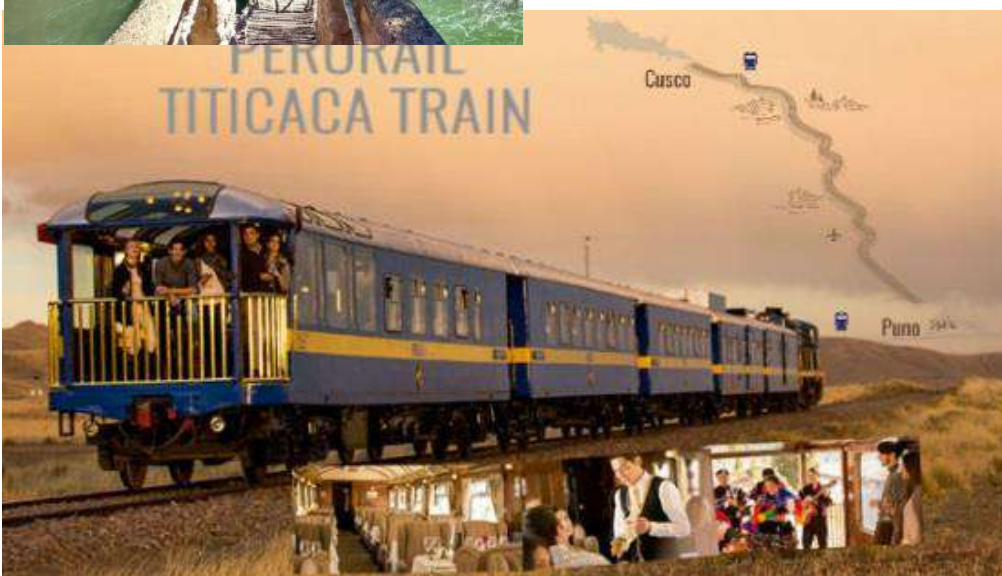


you are done enjoying the scenery, you will make your descent along the path which you came (approx. 20-30min). Your transfer will be waiting at the trailhead to take you to Checacupe where you can walk across the Inca rope suspension bridge. After a break to enjoy boxed lunch, you will be transferred back to hotel in Cusco (approx. arrival time is 1700hrs)

IMPORTANT Due to the height that this trek takes place at, acclimatizing in Cusco beforehand is required.

It then reaches the gentler, rolling Andean Plains, where vicuña and alpaca can be seen. The observation car with bar will provide the perfect opportunity to view the beautiful scenery. A gourmet **lunch** will be served on

Unlike the classic tour, this full day trip by speedboat offers a reduced time en route. Our tour takes you against the flow to avoid the busy tourist crowds offering a more genuine way to experience Titicaca Lake. The first stop is on **Taquile, the weaver's island**. Across the centuries, 'Taquilenos' have preserved traditions, such as a communitarian life where everything is shared. Men always seem to be walking around the island knitting the woollen caps they wear. Around noon you reach the **remote community of Luquina on Chucuito Peninsula**. Locals in this less known area are not visited by mass tourism yet. After lunch

including typical Andean dishes, take time to soak up the mesmerizing views – deep earthy red colour of the soil in the strong highland sunlight contrasts magnificently against the deep blue of Lake Titicaca. The backdrop of the snowcapped Cordillera Real on the far side completes a splendid picture. On your way back to Puno there is a last stop to visit one of the **floating reed island of the Uros**. Your **sightseeing tour in Lima** explores the modern districts of Lima and its historic centre, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1988. Renaissance, Baroque and Neoclassic movements also reached Peru and a handful of well-preserved buildings offer a glimpse of the blend of past and present that characterizes the capital. One of the best examples and included in our tour is the cathedral (16th century) containing the remains of the Spanish conqueror Pizarro. Your next stop is at the Larco Herrera Museum. The collection allows the understanding of 3,000 years of the Peruvian pre-Columbian history in an intuitive way. Its masterpieces are considered worldwide icons of pre-Inca art and have been displayed in the world's most renowned museums. Lunch at Café del Museo Larco Herrera. Full day tour to the National Park Los Glaciares, visiting the Perito Moreno Glacier. This natural monument of extraordinary beauty has been declared by UNESCO as Humanity Patrimony. Once inside the park we will be able to observe the arboreal vegetation of the Patagonia Andean forest, which is mainly from the "notofagus" family. Further on, we will have access to the footbridges of the glacier, with fantastic panoramic viewpoints. In this area there exists a big quantity of glaciers, and the most famous is the Perito Moreno: it has a frontage of 3.12 miles and is 60 metres high above the level of the Argentine Lake, and a total surface that exceeds the one from several big cities of the world. It is one of the few glaciers that is still in full advance. During any season of the year the visitor can enjoy its constant collapses of ice towers that break into multiple ice floes. Boat ride included. Dinner & accommodation.

The tour also includes the magnificent areas of Recoleta and Palermo, with their beautiful parks and buildings, the Colon theatre, one of the five most important Opera theatres of the world and many other buildings and palaces of architectural, historical and cultural value. We will visit San Telmo area, one of the most antique districts of the city, as well as the Boca district, with its "caminito" - a picturesque pedestrian street, where you will find its colourful metal sheet tenements. Finally, the tour will lead us to the recently recycled district of Puerto Madero, old area of the Buenos Aires port
